# JUNE CHALLENGE

*“Generations Growing Together” - Psalm 145:4*





## **Purpose**

The goal of this month-long challenge is to strengthen intergenerational relationships through fellowship, service, honor, mentorship, and spiritual growth rooted in God's Word. Families, ministries, and individuals may participate in whole or in part throughout the month of June.

Recognition will be given based on the number and extent of activities completed. Participants are encouraged to submit pictures, testimonies, receipts, reflections, and other evidence of participation.

The theme scripture for this challenge is Psalm 145:4:

"One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts."

This scripture reminds us that God calls generations to learn from one another, encourage one another, and share their faith experiences. Through intentional relationships, we strengthen our trust in God, deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ, and build a stronger church family.



## **Scripture Reflection Requirement**

As part of the challenge, participants are asked to submit at least one reflection describing what they learned and how the scripture(s) helped shape their experience. Participants may choose to reflect on the theme scripture or any of the weekly scriptures.

Reflection questions may include:

- What did this scripture help you understand about relationships across generations?
- How did this activity strengthen your relationship with God or others?
- What did you learn about honoring, serving, mentoring, or encouraging others?
- How did this scripture become more meaningful through your participation?
- What will you do differently as a result of this experience?

Reflections may be submitted in writing, as a video testimony, or through a brief personal testimony.



## Week 1 — “Honor the Legacy”

### Activity

Create a “Faith Story Wall” with photos, favorite scriptures, testimonies, and words of encouragement from fathers, caregivers, elders, and mentors.

**Scripture**-Exodus 20:12 — “Honour thy father and thy mother...”

### Reflection

This scripture teaches us to honor parents, caregivers, elders, and spiritual leaders through appreciation, respect, and gratitude. Honoring others strengthens families and builds unity within the church.

### Suggested Environment

- Church fellowship hall
- Family gatherings
- Intergenerational breakfast or luncheon

Please submit photos, notes, testimonies, or a brief reflection describing how the scripture or theme deepened your understanding and strengthened your faith as you participated in the challenge.



## Week 2 — “Serve Together”

### Activity

Participate in an Intergenerational Service Day by assembling care bags, helping seniors, cleaning church grounds, or serving meals together.

**Scripture** -Mark 10:45 — “For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister...”

### Reflection

Jesus modeled servant leadership through humility and compassion. Serving together strengthens relationships and reflects the love of Christ.

### Suggested Environment

- Community outreach
- Church service projects
- Senior care visits

### Week 3 — “Fathers of Faith”

#### **Activity**

Honor fathers, caregivers, and spiritual leaders through prayer, fellowship meals, testimony sharing, or family photos.

**Scripture** -Proverbs 20:7 — “The righteous man walketh in his integrity: his children are blessed after him.” **Additional Scripture** -Proverbs 31:25 — “She is clothed with strength and honour...”This reminds us to honor those who demonstrate wisdom, dignity, faithfulness, and godly character.

#### **Reflection**

Godly leadership and integrity leave lasting blessings for future generations. This week encourages us to celebrate faithful fathers, mentors, and caregivers.

#### **Suggested Environment**

- Father’s Day breakfast or luncheon
- Family meals at home
- Church fellowship gatherings

## Week 4 — “Building the Future Together”

### Activity

Create a “Future Church Vision Tree” by writing prayers, ministry ideas, and hopes for future generations.

**Scripture**-Joel 2:28 — “Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy...”

### Reflection

Every generation has value in God’s kingdom. Older generations bring wisdom while younger generations bring vision and creativity. God calls generations to work together.

### Suggested Environment

- Bible study groups
- Youth and senior fellowships
- Worship services

## Church-Wide Challenge

**Throughout June, participants are encouraged to:**

- Sit with a different generation each Sunday
- Pray with someone older or younger
- Share a testimony
- Invite another generation to fellowship

**Scripture**-Romans 12:10 — “Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love...”

### **Reflection**

This scripture reminds us to show kindness, love, honor, and unity to one another as the body of Christ.

Please submit photos, notes, testimonies, or a brief reflection describing how the scripture or theme deepened your understanding and strengthened your faith as you participated in the challenge.



**Participants may submit:**

- Pictures
- Videos
- Testimonies
- Meal or activity receipts
- Journal entries
- Prayer cards
- Written reflections

Recognition will be based on the number and extent of activities completed, as well as the submission of at least one scripture reflection describing how God's Word influenced the participant's experience throughout the challenge.
